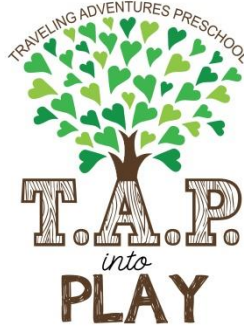

SENSORY PLAY RECIPES

Flubber Gak

5 tablespoons Borax, 2 cups Elmer's Glue, 1 ½ cups water to mix with glue, 1 additional cup of hot water to mix with borax, food color or liquid water color if desired.

Mix 2 cups glue and 1 ½ cups water in bowl. In the cup of hot water, dissolve 5 tbs. of Borax. When dissolved, pour Borax mixture slowly and a little at a time into the glue/water mixture. Watch it coagulate! Mix with your hands or a sturdy spoon. At first it is wet and slimy. Continue kneading until it becomes one big flubber gak ball. It will keep in an air tight container or Ziploc bag for a few weeks. When it begins to flick apart or get too hard, it is time to make a new batch. For a fun activity with your flubber, use drinking straws to blow big flubber bubbles. Enjoy!

Oobleck

2 parts cornstarch
1 part water

Mix until drips between fingers

Play Dough

3 cups flour
1 ½ cups salt
3 tablespoons cream of tartar
3 cups water
1/3 cup cooking oil
Food coloring at least 1 tablespoon depending on desired color

In a saucepan combine the dry ingredients.

Gradually stir in oil, water, food coloring, until all is blended.

Turn on heat to medium, stir constantly until lumps are gone and mixture forms a ball.

Cool slightly and knead to remove lumps.

When cool, store in air tight container.
